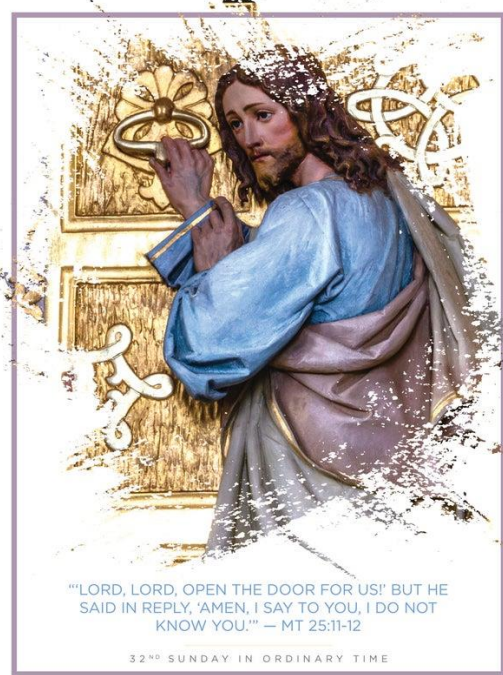

Fr. Paul Cox

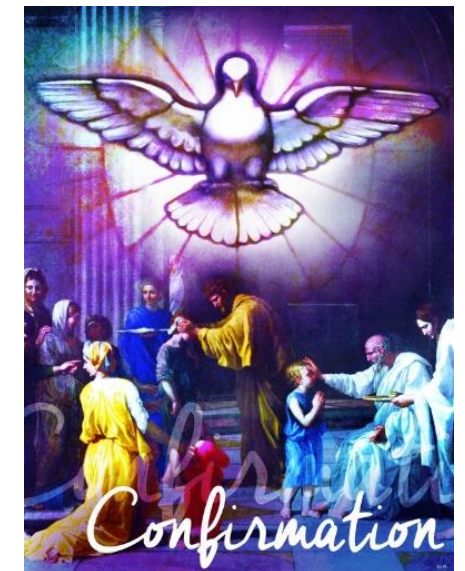
